

The 1st school we visited was Acworth Intermediate School in Cobb County. Over 2 days the BlazeSports staff together with Coach Jackson and Coach Bobo introduced the whole school to a variety of Paralympic sports. The students were delighted to try out the sports and especially enjoyed racing the wheelchairs.





Our next visit took us to Conley Hills Elementary in Fulton County where the students took part in goal ball, wheelchair relays, sitting volleyball and bocchia. Many students had questions at the end about other sports for people with disabilities and were surprised to learn that there is a huge variety of adapted sports for all ages.



The final stop on our tour took us to Coralwood School in Dekalb County. Coralwood

School has a truly unique student population, with more than half having some form of disability. The school has Preschool, Pre-Kindergarten, and Kindergarten classes and every child was excited to try out the adapted games. Goal Ball and wheelchair relays especially were a big hit with the children with visual impairments.
